'The Project for Construction of Classroom Building for Global Harvest School'

On 29th May, 2018, a Handing Over Ceremony for 'The Project for Construction of Classroom Building for Global Harvest School' was held at Gilbert Camp District of East Honiara in Guadalcanal Province.

The Government of Japan supported the school through grant assistance amounting to US \$65,057 (SBD\$504,191.⁷⁵) for the construction of classroom building (2-story, 6 classrooms) for the purpose of solving classroom shortage issues.

The Ceremony was held on a grand scale with approximately 200 attendees including Ambassador Shigeru Toyama and Mrs. Toyama, Ministry of Education Representative and Prime Minister's Office Representative. The School Chairman acknowledged 'Education is the most powerful weapon which can change the world. So we express our appreciation for the special grant funding support from Japan.'
