The Grant Contract Signing Ceremony for five(5) Projects under the Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects(GGP) 2018

On 16th and 17th January, 2019, Grant Contract Signing Ceremonies for the Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects (GGP) programme were held at the Embassy of Japan. Japanese Ambassador Shigeru Toyama signed five (5) contracts with the representatives of the recipient organizations.

According to these newly agreed contracts, the Government of Japan will provide financial assistance for a total of approximately US\$376,000 (SBD\$3,000,000) for these development projects. The following projects have been signed:

1. The Project for Construction of Classroom Building for Veramogho Primary School

Recipient: Veramogho Primary School (Guadalcanal Province)

Total amount of Grant: US\$63, 532 (SBD504, 444)

Overview of the Project: Single-story classroom building with 2 classrooms and staff room.

The project aims to solve one-room school issue due to the classroom shortage and provide better learning and teaching

environment.





2. The Project for Construction of Classroom Building for Su'umoli Primary And Community High School

Recipient: Su'umoli Primary Community High School (Makira Ulawa Province)

Total amount of Grant: US\$80, 050 (SBD635, 597)

Overview of the Project: Double-story classroom building with 6 classrooms.

Through the project, the students will no longer learn and experience attending classes in crowded and makeshift classrooms at the damaged classroom building. Their comfortable and proper learning environment will be improved.





3. 「The Project for Construction of Titiana Community Hall and Tsunami Evacuation Centre」

Recipient: Western Provincial Disaster Management Office (Western Province)

Total amount of Grant: US\$89, 284 (SBD708, 914)

Overview of the Project: Community Hall and Evacuation Centre with office, storage, kitchen, 4 toilets.

The completion of the project will benefit about 800 people at tsunami hazard area to have a proper community hall and evacuation facility.





4. 「The Project for Construction of Classroom Building and Staff House for Varu Primary School」

Recipient: Varu Primary School (Western Province)

Total amount of Grant: US\$81, 321 (SBD645, 688)

Overview of the Project: Single-story classroom building with 3 classrooms and Staff house with 3 bed rooms.

The project is expected to solve crowded classes and the shortage of staff house due to one-room school and provide better learning

environment.





5. The Project for Construction of Classroom Building for Kaotave Vocational Rural Training Centre

Recipient: Kaotave Vocational Rural Training Centre (Guadalcanal Province)

Total amount of Grant: US\$62, 261 (SBD494, 352)

Overview of the Project: Double-story classroom building with 6 classrooms.

The Project aims to provide unemployed youth people an improved training facility and increase opportunities for employment.
