The Grant Contract Signing Ceremony for three(3) Projects under the Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects(GGP) 2018

On 27th February, 2019, Grant Contract Signing Ceremonies for the Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects (GGP) programme were held at the Embassy of Japan. Japanese Ambassador Shigeru Toyama signed three(3) contracts with the representatives of the recipient organizations.

According to these newly agreed contracts, the Government of Japan will provide financial assistance for a total of approximately US\$230,000 (SBD\$1,850,000) for these development projects. The following projects have been signed:

1. The Project for Provision of Garbage Truck for Honiara City

Recipient: Honiara City Council (Honiara City in Guadalcanal Province) Total amount of Grant: US\$75,000 (SBD597,000)

Overview of the Project: One garbage truck (new).

The project aims to improve better hygienic environment and public service in Honiara City such as collection of general waste due to rapid population increase and economic growth.



2. The Project for Construction of Boys' Dormitory for Kukele Community High School R e c i p i e n t: Kukele Community High School (Choiseul Province) Total amount of Grant: US\$85,000 (SBD676,600) Overview of the Project: Double-story dormitory with 6 bedrooms, Laundry space,

3 toilets and 1 raintank.

The project is expected to improve better learning environment for the boarding students so that they will no longer bear living at the damaged dormitory.



3. The Project for Construction of Classroom Building for Turarana Community High School Recipient: Turarana Community High School (Guadalcanal Province)

Total amount of Grant: US\$70, 694 (SBD562, 724)

Overview of the Project: Double-story classroom building with 6 classrooms.

Through this project, a classroom building will be constructed to provide safer learning environment and newly established classes for the students.
