

**The Grant Contract Signing Ceremony
for two(2) Projects under the Grant Assistance
for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects(GGP) 2018**

On 14th March, 2019, Grant Contract Signing Ceremonies for the Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects (GGP) programme were held at the Embassy of Japan. Japanese Ambassador Shigeru Toyama signed two(2) contracts with the representatives of the recipient organizations.

According to these newly agreed contracts, the Government of Japan will provide financial assistance of a total of approximately US\$150,000 (SBD\$1,200,000) for these development projects. The following projects have been signed:

1. The Project for Improvement of Water Supply and Sanitation for Kmaga Community
Recipient: The Health and Medical Services Division of Isabel Provincial Government, Environmental Health Division (Isabel Province)
Total amount of Grant: US\$62,500 (SBD498,125)
Overview of the Project : Water supply system (pipeline, 2 water storage tanks and 30 standpipes) and 30 public toilets
Through the project, the water supply system will be furnished to provide better water access and installed new public toilets to reduce water-borne diseases for their community. Once completed, it is expected to benefit 60 households/ 500 residents.



2. The Project for Construction of Classroom Building for Bunitusu Primary School

Recipient: Bunitusu Primary School (Western Province)

Total amount of Grant: US\$87,500 (SBD697,375)

Overview of the Project: Double-story classroom building with 6 classrooms.

This project aims to rebuild the only previous classroom building which has fully collapsed and provide the safe educational infrastructure so that the students can improve better learning environment at a solid classroom building.
