

**Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects**  
**Handing Over Ceremony of**  
**‘The Project for Construction of Classroom Building and Student Dormitory**  
**for Tenakoga Primary School’**

On 14<sup>th</sup> May, 2019, a Handing Over Ceremony for ‘The Project for Construction of Classroom Building and Student Dormitory for Tenakoga Primary School’ was held at Tenakoga District in Guadalcanal Province. The ceremony was attended by approximately 500 people including Ambassador Shigeru Toyama, Head teacher of Tenakoga Primary School and Premier of Guadalcanal Province.

The Government of Japan supported the school through grant assistance amounting to US \$88,917 (SBD\$685,439) for the construction of classroom building(double-story with 6 classrooms) and two dormitories for the purpose of solving their dilapidated facilities. With this project, the students will be able to receive basic education and improve the learning skills. The school is also expected to accept more students who live far away and increase student enrollment.

Ambassador Toyama said in his remarks, ‘I am pleased that this project has been completed successfully. I hope the facilities will be remembered as a symbol of the friendship between the people of Japan and Solomon Islands for many years to come.’ The head teacher appreciated all the support by the Government and People of Japan and appealed the importance of education to the parents and children.
