Handing Over Ceremony of
‘The Project for Loimuni Rural Health Clinic Infrastructure’

On 3rd July, 2019, a Handing Over Ceremony for ‘The Project for Loimuni Rural Health Clinic Infrastructure’ was held at North West District in Choiseul Province. The ceremony was attended by approximately 300 people including Ambassador Shigeru Toyama, representatives of Provincial Health Services and Provincial Government.

The Government of Japan supported the Choiseul Provincial Health Services through grant assistance amounting to US \$82,271 (SBD\$637,336) for the construction of clinic (single-story building with 7 rooms and toilets) and two raintanks. People who live in the surrounding areas will be able to have better access to the primary medical services with this project.

Ambassador Toyama said in his remarks, ‘I am very pleased that Japan was able to contribute to further developments of Solomon Island through the project, and I hope that this facility will be well maintained so that it will benefit many generations in your communities. The director of Provincial Health Services appreciated all the continuous supports to Choiseul Province by the Government and People of Japan. Also, the Chief said ‘Our first Japanese visitors in our community were soldiers during the world war II. And next Japanese visitors brought this clinic project for us. We would like to say thank you so much from bottom of our hearts for your wonderful gift.’
