

**Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects**  
**Handing Over Ceremony of**  
**‘The Project for Construction of Classroom Building for**  
**Turarana Community High School’**

On 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2019, a Handing Over Ceremony for ‘The Project for Construction of Classroom Building for Turarana Community High School’ was held at Gold Ridge District in Guadalcanal Province. The ceremony was attended by approximately 400 people including Ambassador Shigeru Toyama, Principal of Turarana Community High School and Representative of Guadalcanal Provincial Education Office.

The Government of Japan supported the school through grant assistance amounting to US\$70,694 (SBD\$562,724) for the construction of classroom building (double-story with 6 classrooms). The project is expected to provide safer and better learning environment and taking higher education by newly established classes for the students.

Ambassador Toyama said in his remarks, ‘Please remember that from now, you have started to take good care of your own classrooms so that the building will benefit your little brothers, sisters and many generations of your community and the surrounding areas.’ The principal said ‘We really appreciate the enormous and generous gift from Japan. Your support will be forever remembered by the students and community and this classroom building will be treasured by them.’
