Handing Over Ceremony of
‘The Project for Provision of Garbage Truck for Honiara City’

On 21st October, 2019, a Handing Over Ceremony for ‘The Project for Provision of Garbage Truck for Honiara City’ was held in Honiara City. The ceremony was attended by Ambassador Shigeru Toyama, City Mayor, three JICA representatives and other stakeholders.

The Government of Japan supported the Honiara City Council through grant assistance amounting to US\$75,000 (SBD\$597,000) to provide one garbage truck. The project aims to improve waste management due to rapid population increase and economic growth in the urban areas.

Ambassador Toyama said in his remarks, ‘I am very glad that this project will be able to alleviate the garbage issues in Honiara City which is getting serious year by year. In addition, I hope it would be able to collaborate well with Japanese technical cooperation Project ‘J-PRISM Phase II’ under JICA.’ The City Mayor appreciated the support by the Japanese Government and he promised that they will take good care of the vehicle to solve the issues in the city.
