The Grant Contract Signing Ceremony for two(2) Projects under the Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects(GGP) 2019

On 6th November, 2019, Grant Contract Signing Ceremonies for the Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects (GGP) programme were held at the Embassy of Japan. Japanese Ambassador Shigeru Toyama signed two(2) contracts with the representatives of the recipient organizations.

According to these newly agreed contracts, the Government of Japan will provide financial assistance of a total of approximately US\$150,000 (SBD\$1,200,000) for these development projects. The following projects have been signed:

- The Project for Construction of Classroom Building and Staff House for Kopiu Primary School R e c i p i e n t: Kopiu Primary School (Guadalcanal Province) Total amount of Grant: US\$66, 997 (SBD542, 675)
 - Overview of the Project: Single-story classroom building with 3 classrooms and Staff house with 3 bed rooms. Through the project, the new classroom will be rebuild to solve one-room school issue and shortage of staff house and improve their basic educational environment.



2. The Project for Construction of Classroom Building for Gwaunasu Community High School R e c i p i e n t: Gwaunasu Community High School (Malaita Province) Total amount of Grant: US\$83, 126 (SBD673, 320)

Overview of the Project: Double-story classroom building with 6 classrooms.

This project aims to accept the large number of student enrollment including newly established classes and provide better learning environment.
