

**Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects**  
**Handing Over Ceremony of**  
**‘The Project for Construction of Classroom Building for Su’ umoli Primary And Community High School’**

On 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2019, a Handing Over Ceremony for ‘The Project for Construction of Classroom Building for Su’ umolo Community High School’ was held in Urawa Island of Makira Urawa Province. The ceremony was attended by Provincial Principal Education Officer, School Principal, School Chairman and other stakeholders and approximately 500 residents joined the programme.

The Government of Japan supported the school through grant assistance amounting to US\$80,050 (SBD\$635,597) to build a double-story classroom building with 6 classrooms. Through the project, the students will no longer attend classes in crowded and makeshift classrooms at the damaged classroom building and their learning environment will be improved.

The School Principal said in his remarks, ‘After a long struggle and dream, we finally managed to take a step forward by achieving one of our priority goals to build the new classroom building.’ He appreciated Japan’s heartfelt support and promised to maintain the facility well so that many children surrounding the areas will be able to benefit for many years to come.
