The Grant Contract Signing Ceremony for two(2) Projects under the Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects(GGP) 2019

On 11th December, 2019, Grant Contract Signing Ceremonies for the Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects (GGP) programme were held at the Embassy of Japan. Japanese Ambassador Shigeru Toyama signed two(2) contracts with the representatives of the recipient organizations.

According to these newly agreed contracts, the Government of Japan will provide financial assistance of a total of approximately US\$172,000 (SBD\$1,400,000) for these development projects. The following projects have been signed:

1. The Project for Construction of Classroom Building for Valapata Primary School

Recipient: Valapata Primary School (Western Province)

Total amount of Grant: US\$85, 607 (SBD695, 128)

Overview of the Project: Double-story classroom building with 6 classrooms.

Through the project, a new classroom will be built for replacing the existing classroom building which is in danger of collapse caused by big earthquake. It will improve their educational

environment.





2. The Project for Construction of Boys' Dormitory for St. Joseph's Moli Catholic Secondary School

Recipient: St. Joseph's Moli Catholic Secondary School (Choiseul Province)

Total amount of Grant: US\$86, 419 (SBD701, 722)

Overview of the Project: Double-story dormitory with 4 bedrooms, 1 housemaster's room and 1 bathroom(3 showers and 3 toilets).

This project aims to solve an overcrowding issue at the boys' dormitory due to increased number of students. It will provide more comfortable dormitory life and better learning environment for the students.
