Handing Over Ceremony of
‘The Project for Construction of Classroom Building for Gwaunasu Community High School’

On 12th March, 2020, a Handing Over Ceremony for ‘The Project for Construction of Classroom Building for Gwaunasu Community High School’ was held in Lau-Baelelea District of Malaita Province. The ceremony was attended by approximately 500 people including school and community representatives.

The Government of Japan supported Gwaunasu Community High School through grant assistance amounting to US\$83,126 (SBD\$673,320) for the construction of double-story classroom building (6 classrooms) to solve the classroom shortage due to increase of rapid school enrollment and newly established Form 5 class. The project is expected that the school will be able to provide proper learning environment to the students and improve the quality of education service.

The school principal said in his remarks, ‘We would like to say thank you for the government and people of Japan for coming to our aid in our desperate situation. We sincerely promise to maintain the building well with our community.’
