The Grant Contract Signing Ceremony for two(2) Projects under the Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects(GGP) 2019

On 19th March, 2020, Grant Contract Signing Ceremonies for the Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects (GGP) programme were held at the Embassy of Japan. Japanese Ambassador Shigeru Toyama signed contracts with the representative of the Health and Medical Services Division of Isabel Provincial Government.

According to these newly agreed two(2) contracts, the Government of Japan will provide financial assistance of a total of approximately US\$141,000 (SBD\$1,150,000) for these development projects. The following projects have been signed:

1. The Project for Improvement of Water Supply for Kosisi Community

Recipient: The Health and Medical Services Division of Isabel Provincial Government, Environmental Health Division (Isabel Province)

Total amount of Grant: US\$84, 766 (SBD691, 690)

Overview of the Project: Water supply system (extension of existing dam, water storage tank and 28 standpipes)

Through the project, the water supply system will be rehabilitated so that 40 households/ 400 residents in the community will be able to alleviate the serious shortage of water.





2. The Project for Improvement of Water Supply and Sanitation for Hurepelo Community
Recipient: The Health and Medical Services Division of Isabel Provincial
Government, Environmental Health Division (Isabel Province)

Total amount of Grant: US\$56, 441 (SBD460, 558)

Overview of the Project: Water supply system (dam, break pressure tank, water storage tank and 24 standpipes) and 8 public toilets.

Through the project, the community with 45 households/ 300 residents and primary school with 100 students at primary school will be able to improve the hygienic environment and secure their healthy lives.
