

**for four (4) Projects under the Grant Assistance  
for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects (GGP) 2020**

On 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> November, 2020, Grant Contract Signing Ceremonies for the Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects (GGP) programme were held at the Embassy of Japan. Japanese Ambassador Yasuhiro Morimoto signed four (4) contracts with the representatives of the recipient organizations.

According to these newly agreed contracts, the Government of Japan will provide financial assistance of a total of approximately US\$298,000 (SBD\$2,400,000) for these development projects. The following projects have been signed:

1. The Project for Construction of Classroom Building for St. Dominic' s Vocational Rural Training Centre  
R e c i p i e n t : St. Dominic' s Vocational Rural Training Centre (Western Province)  
Total amount of Grant : US\$77,681 (SBD621,448)  
Overview of the Project : Double-story classroom building with 3 classrooms, 2 work rooms and 1 storage.  
The project is expected to improve learning environment of the training centre and promote human resource development for local youth with better vocational skill.



## 2. The Project for Provision of Garbage Truck for Auki Town

Recipient: Malaita Provincial Government (Malaita Province)

Total amount of Grant: US\$80,448 (SBD642,779)

Overview of the Project: One garbage truck (new).

The project aims to improve the hygiene and waste management system in Auki town by increasing solid waste collection.



## 3. The Project for Construction of Classroom Building for New Vunuha Primary School

Recipient: New Vunuha Primary School (Central Province)

Total amount of Grant: US\$55,487 (SBD443,341)

Overview of the Project: Raised-floor classroom building with 3 classrooms.

Through the project, a new classroom building will be built for replacing the existing makeshift buildings to improve learning environment for children and quality of basic education at the school.



#### 4. The Project for Construction of Dormitories for Katova Community High School

Recipient: Katova Community High School Committee (Isabel Province)

Total amount of Grant: US\$84,682 (SBD677,456)

Overview of the Project: 2 student dormitories (boys-1, girls-1) with bedrooms and storages.

The completion of the project will benefit many boarding students and improve access to secondary education opportunity at the school district.
