Handing Over Ceremony of
‘The Project for Construction of Boys’ Dormitory for Kukele Community High School’

On 11th February, 2021, a Handing Over Ceremony for ‘The Project for Construction of Boys’ Dormitory for Kukele Community High School’ under the Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects (GGP) was held in North-East District of Choiseul Province.

The Government of Japan supported Kukele Community High School through grant assistance amounting to US\$85,000 (SBD\$676,600) to build a double-story dormitory (6 bedrooms, 3 toilets and 1 rain tank).

In presence of the school representatives, approximately 300 people from nearby communities attended the ceremony, and they witnessed the handing over of new boys’ dormitory to the school. The school principal, in his speech at the ceremony, thanked to the Government of Japan for funding the new dormitory to their school. He highlighted that the project saved them out of a school closure crisis, due to deterioration of the existing dormitory building.

The school will be able to provide the students more comfortable dormitory space and improve their boarding environment. Thus, they are expected to accept more students after the completion of new building.
