Handing Over Ceremony of
‘The Project for Construction of Dormitories for Katova Community High School’

On 14th September, 2021, a Handing Over Ceremony for ‘The Project for Construction of Dormitories for Katova Community High School’ was held in Santa Isabel island of Isabel Province. The ceremony was attended by Ambassador MORIMOTO Yasuhiro, the Principal of Katova community high school and other stakeholders.

The Government of Japan supported Katova Community High School Committee through the grant assistance amounting to US\$84,682 (SBD\$677,456) to build 2 dormitories for the students.

In presence of the school representatives, approximately 100 people from nearby communities attended the ceremony, and they witnessed the handing over of new boys’ dormitory to the school. The school principal, in his speech at the ceremony, thanked to the Government of Japan for funding the new dormitory to their school. He highlighted that the project saved them out of a school closure crisis, due to deterioration of the existing dormitory building.

The school will be able to provide the students more comfortable dormitory space and improve their boarding environment. Thus, they are expected to accept more students after the completion of new building.

Ambassador MORIMOTO said in his remarks, ‘I hope that the new dormitories will benefit many generations of Katova community and surrounding areas.’ The Principal appreciated the generous support by the Japanese Government and promised to take good care of the facility for many years to come.
